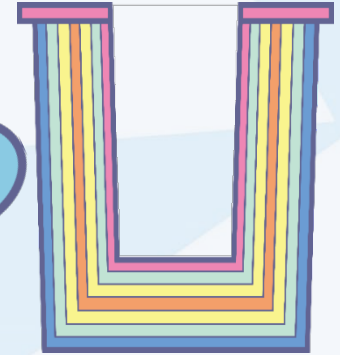




## Multi-Layer/Multi-Function Packaging

## Ice Cream / Dessert

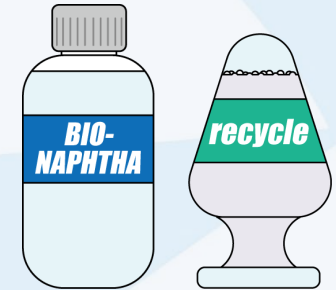

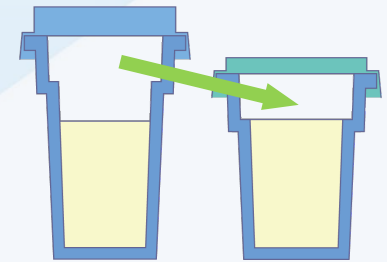
## Recycled Material

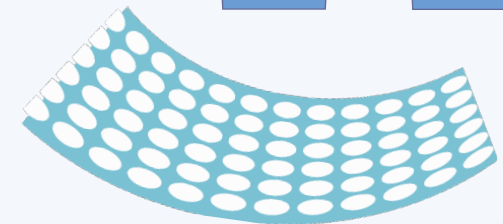
## Lightweight Design

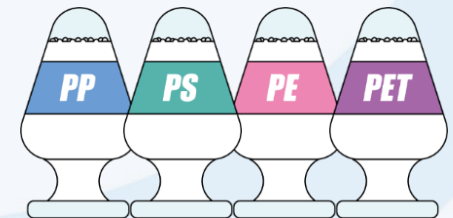
## Reducing Waste
